Maryland Wing 2004 Cadet Solo Flight Scholarship Program

What: Fifteen hours of primary flight instruction and a complete private pilot ground school. At the completion of the course, the FAA Private Pilot written exam will be given by an FAA designated examiner at a computerized exam facility.

Where: Planned location will be Hagerstown Composite Squadron Building with flying at Washington County Airport.

When: From 2000 local Friday evening 2 July 2004 through 1700 local Sunday 11 July 2004. Sufficient time is allowed to complete the program in the event of inclement weather. The FAA Private Pilot Written Examination will be scheduled for July 11, 2004. After completing the written testing, participants will be dismissed to return home.

Minimum Requirements:

- Mitchell
- 16 years of age (by June 1, 2004)
- Nomination by Unit Commander
- Completion of all five powered Cadet Orientation flights.
- Minimum of a C average on the previous semester/quarter report card
- Parental consent form (CAP Form 31)
- Class III FAA Medical and Student Pilot
- Certificate (this is to be submitted after notification of selection in the program)

How to Apply: By written application to include the following information:

- Proof of Mitchell or higher certificate
- Completed CAP Form 31
- Letter of nomination from your Unit Commander
- Copy of past semester/quarter=s report card
- Resume listing, at a minimum, your present and past years participation in CAP activities and any previous flight training or ground instruction towards a private pilot certificate.
- One page, or less, narrative letter of application stating your reason(s) for applying and how you would use the training if accepted into the program.

Costs: There will be a single one time fee of \$600.00 for each cadet accepted into the program. The fee will be payable, by check to Maryland Wing CAP, on the date set forth below. All other costs will be paid by Maryland Wing.

Schedule: 09 February 2004 - First Announcement
05 April 2004 - Deadline for receipt of applications
03 May 2004 - Applicant interviews with the selection board at Wing Headquarters
10 May 2004 - Announcement of selectees and alternates
04 June - 06 June 2004 - Cadet Solo Scholarship ground school weekend (Frederick Composite Squadron Headquarters)
7 June 2004 - Deadline for submitting proof of FAA Medical/Student Pilot Certificate and payment of fees.
2 July - 11 July 2004 - Completion of Ground School and flight training program.

Additional

Scholarships: Contingent upon funding, one or more of the top rated cadets participating in this solo program may be awarded either full or partial scholarship(s), by Maryland Wing, towards the completion of their private pilot certificate. Additional details on this program will be provided at a later date.
